Rules and Regulations

Camp Ozone has been dedicated to the glory of God. It is our desire that your time spent here will be refreshing and beneficial. In order to maintain the intended atmosphere at Camp Ozone and ensure the safety of our guests, guest groups should be individuals of Christian character and be willing to live within the guidelines of Christian principles and the specific standards established by Camp Ozone.

- Any act of intentional vandalism or destructive, injurious, or mischievous behavior may result in immediate dismissal from the camp and / or assistance from the local authorities as deemed necessary by camp management.
- No illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, or weapons of any kind are allowed on camp property.
- Smoking is not allowed in any of the buildings. Cigarette butts should be put in the trash or designated receptacle and NOT on the ground.
- Camp Ozone reserves the right to ask anyone with unacceptable behavior to leave.
- Park all vehicles in designated parking areas only. Vehicles are NOT to be used as transportation within the facility.
- The SPEED LIMIT is 15 mph inside the camp entrance and 10 mph on the loop by the cabins and lodge.
- The use of Camp Ozone service vehicles is reserved for the Camp Ozone staff only.
- No children / teens are allowed to be near the water or on trails without a responsible adult chaperone.
- No one is allowed to swim or use water equipment without permission from camp administration.
- If use of canoes, kayaks or paddle boat are arranged, life jackets must be worn by all participants. No children should use boats unless supervised by a responsible adult.

- No boys are allowed in the girls' cabins. No girls are allowed in the boys' cabins.
- No pets allowed.
- Evening curfew is 11pm unless special arrangements are made with camp administration. This means everyone is expected to be in their cabin by 11pm and quiet by midnight.
- All cabins, restrooms, meeting areas, and grounds shall be kept in proper order.
- Camp Ozone insurance does not cover any pre-existing medical condition. In case of accident or injury, Camp Ozone insurance will be submitted as secondary to your primary insurance.

During your stay:

1. Help ensure the observance of the Camp Regulations by each member of your group
2. Communicate with the camp staff regarding your needs and how we can assist you

Before departure:

1. Each guest has all of his/her belongings.
2. The cabins, restrooms and meeting areas are swept clean.
3. Please remove all sheets and pillowcases and place them at the end of the mattress for collection
4. Bagged trash is transferred to the outside receptacles.
5. The grounds are left neat, clean and free of matter foreign to the area
6. All borrowed equipment and materials are returned
7. Any breakage or loss is reported to camp management
8. Confirm number in attendance and complete final billing worksheet
9. Final bill is paid at check-out
